Competitors may use the official accompanists or their own. Please state requirements on the application form. Please submit a copy of accompaniments and scripts with the application, noting the class number. This also applies to students using their own accompanists.

Accompaniments must be presented in an acceptable manner for the accompanist to use on the day.

Time limits must be strictly observed and in the case of own choice pieces, timings should be submitted on the entry form.

No flash photography is permitted during performances.

Any text/song material containing graphic language or swearing must be submitted in full so that an age-appropriate audience can be accommodated. The panel reserve the right to reject entries that are deemed unsuitable.

Age limits are applicable as of the first day of the festival i.e. Thursday 14 March 2024.

Backing Tracks

All backing tracks must be sent in the format of mp3, via email, no later than 8 March 2024. If the correct format is not sent by this date, then the festival will hold no responsibility for any detriment caused to the performance.


