Life outside the classroom should be rich and rewarding. School years are an important time for trying out new skills and activities, which can give lifelong pleasure. Hill House offers a very full and vibrant programme of extra-curricular activities, which are additional to those offered as part of the normal school day. Over 100 activities are offered each term, which take place either before school, at lunchtime or after school, most of which are included in the school fees. A small number of activities have a charge, activities such as horse riding, tae kwon do, ballet, tap, Kixx and RuggerEds.

Please note that whilst most activities are allocated on a random selection process, not first come first served, horse riding and tae kwon do will give priority to those who have been attending the activity previously.

Some activities such as sports and music may already have a compulsory list which means that pupils are allocated to the activity. These will take priority over other choices. If a pupil is selected for more than one activity on an evening, one activity will take priority for senior school pupils. The activities that take priority are the following. Monday is music, Tuesday is sports, Wednesday is drama, Thursday is academic and Friday is Duke of Edinburgh.

Please take a look and then log in to the Parent Portal to make your booking selections from Tuesday 23rd August 2022. Your requests will be processed, and you will be informed of your allocations before the start of next term.

Horse Riding

The 1 hour 4.30-5.30 activity is riding only. The 2 hour activity, which runs from 4.30-6.30, is an hour's riding followed by an hour's horse care/competition practice. Collection from Grove House Stables by parents at 5:30pm or 6:30pm respectively. Where possible, the children need their own equipment, however, hats and boots can be borrowed from the stables. All riders must wear leggings, a suitable non-hooded top/jacket and riding gloves. Please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions. The school will provide transport to Grove House Stables, the bus will leave school at 4:10pm prompt. The 1 hour activity is chargeable at £22.50 per week and the 2 hour activity at £30 per week (full term to be booked and paid in advance). Sessions will run at various ability levels: Beginner, Bronze/Silver and Gold. Pupils who have ridden at Grove House previously will be graded and allocated to an ability appropriate group. Riders who have not ridden at Grove House previously should choose "Beginner" if they have never ridden before, "Bronze/Silver" if they are reasonably confident at walk and trot and are beginning to canter, and "Gold" if they ride confidently at all three gaits and have some jumping experience.
